From the Pastor

Rev. Libby Rollins

We all knew this was coming, but that doesn't make it any easier! My contract with you as Interim Pastor will be coming to an end next month and I'll be moving on. My last Sunday in the pulpit will be September 11. It is with such mixed emotions that I think about leaving.

First of all, serving with you for the past two years has been an extreme joy. You have been so welcoming and supportive, and for that, I will forever be grateful. We have laughed, learned, worshipped, and worked hard. And there's been no shortage of great food!! You have been patient with me as I learned your ways and traditions, and even shown grace and forgiveness in the times I didn't get it right. It has been a delight to be your partner in ministry and I will be sad to go. I move on with a heavy heart, wishing I could have seen you to the finish line of this process.

Rest assured that your session is working with me to plan for the in between time to make sure that your pastoral needs are addressed. Details will be shared as plans are firmed up in the coming weeks.

We still have six weeks together, but it is not too late for me to start saying thank you, because the list of reasons to thank you is so long. Most importantly, thank you for being a place of welcome, grace, and compassion, not only to me, but also to my family. I was honored to be your partner. It was truly a pleasure to serve with you. 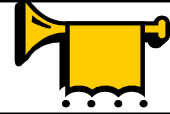

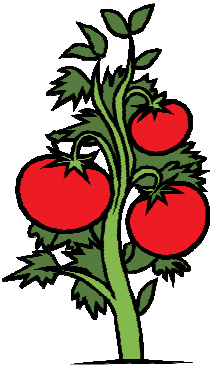
Scholarship Awards:

Four graduates of Suffolk Public Schools have received college financial assistance from scholarship funds established by two sisters who were members of Suffolk Presbyterian Church.

The \$3,000 scholarships, awarded from combined funds of the Willis-Volper endowments, were announced at the 2016 awards ceremonies at the three Suffolk public high schools. The scholarships provide \$1,500 a year for the first two years of post-secondary education.

The funds were given by Violet Volper Pond and her husband, the late C.B. Pond, Jr., in memory of her daughter, Brenda Beamon Willis, and by Edith Volper Buttafoco in memory of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Albert C. Volper.

Search for New Pastor Continues

The search goes on!

Your Pastor Nominating Committee has been hard at work for six months. After reading more than 100 PIFs (Pastor Information Forms), we have conducted interviews via Skype with five candidates. Now, we hope to arrange face-to-face interviews with some of those individuals so we can get to know one another better.

We are not only interviewing candidates, but they are interviewing us as well. There is no "perfect pastor" or "perfect church," though the pairing that God has in mind will be a perfect match.

We have received PIFs (much like resumes) from pastors from all parts of the country, ranging in age from their 20s into their 80s, with men outnumbering women. Some have had little experience; others have spent years in pastoral ministry. Many have served large churches; some have cared for smaller congregations. They have attended seminaries across the U.S., some Presbyterian and some associated with other denominations.

We have found many excellent pastors, dynamic preachers and caring individuals. But finding the right pastor for Suffolk Presbyterian Church in 2016, the pastor that God has chosen to lead our congregation as we begin the next phase of our ministry, is a time-consuming, complicated task. The process takes a lot of prayer and discernment.

That's where you come in.

On behalf of the rest of your PNC - **Michelle Elich, Rob Saunders, Alison Super, and Don White**, I urge you to pray daily that God will help us and our next pastor find one another in a timely manner.

To God be the glory!

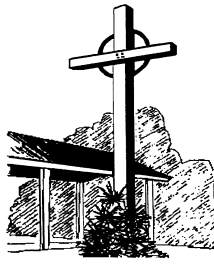
